Z21 and the Bend Bulletin report Deschutes County has applications for two 100 acre solar energy farms near Big Sky Park.

That puts them less than 7,000 feet from the turn from downwind to base on Runway 34. There is some concern that the glare from the solar panels in the morning could be hazardous.

The FAA is soon to release rules requiring a Glare Study, but these projects have not done any such study. They may manage to get approval before the new requirements take effect.

The deadline for comments to the county is April 24.
